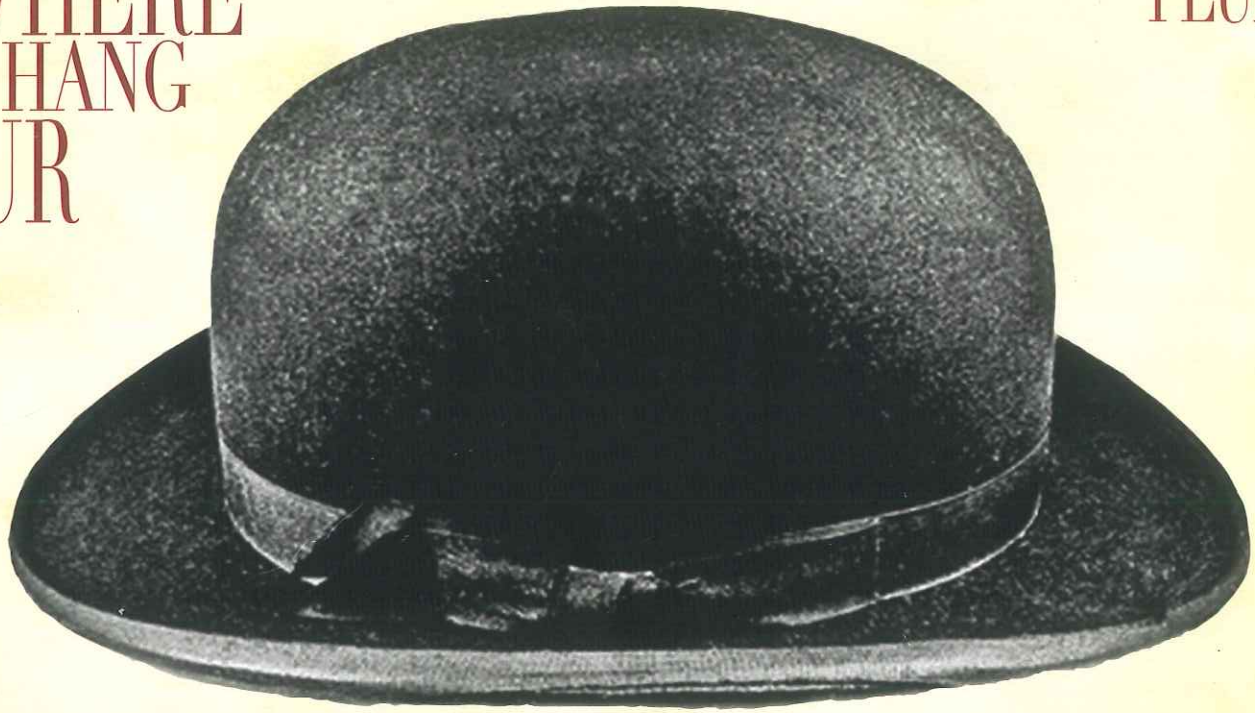

As part of the 100th anniversary of the PAA, *Home Is Where You Hang Your Hat* incorporates newly commissioned works by five Philadelphia-based design/build firms to create five separate but interrelated installations based on the history of the Wetherill mansion and the contemporary concept of the “house.”

Each installation takes into account the ideological meanings associated with the history of domestic architecture, the original function of the building as a residence, and the physical features of the first and second floor galleries of the Art Alliance. The resulting installations are not an historical recreation of the building as a private home, but an interpretation of the concept of home—as a reflection of both social anxieties and desires—for a contemporary audience.
